

Coronavirus

Practical ideas for supporting pupils' wellbeing and mental health



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01

Provide structure, routine and fun activities to create a sense of safety in the school. Involve the student council and wellbeing team in this.

02

Create opportunities for pupils to talk to each other about their lockdown experiences during tutor time, PSHE and lunchtime and after school enrichment clubs.

03

Praise pupils who have gone the extra mile during the pandemic around the school and during school assemblies.

04

If you have pastoral responsibilities, be available at specific times so students, parents or teachers can speak with you about concerns or worries.

05

Provide time and space for pupils to reconnect with each other.

06

Talk about coronavirus. Help pupils see what they can control.

07

Ensure pupils know they can receive support in specific curriculum areas where they feel they may need additional help.

08

Stay calm yourself and emphasise calming activities such as PE, art and music.

09

Introduce movement and brain breaks for those struggling with concentration now they are back at school.


